## Full-Day Private Tour to Argolis - Corinth, Mycenae + Nafplio with Wine Tasting:

Traveling westward from Athens along the coast this morning, you'll have wonderful views of the Saronic Gulf and its picturesque isles. See the impressive Corinth Canal before continuing to Mycenae, a fascinating archaeological site known as the City of Agamemnon – leader of the ancient Greeks during the Trojan War. After a delightful lunch and wine tasting at the Domaine Skouras Winery, continue to Argos - one of the most important cities of ancient times. Then enjoy a guided walking tour in the beautiful waterfront town of Nafplio before returning to Athens in the early evening. *This is a comprehensive full-day excursion lasting 12 to 14 hours. **Private Tour to Cape Sounion with Lunch:** Departing Athens with your chauffeured vehicle and private guide, this delightful excursion begins with a scenic drive along the Saronic Gulf, home to beautiful beaches and picturesque bays. Your destination is the southern coast of Cape Sounion, home to one of the region's most impressive archaeological sites: The Temple of Poseidon. Set on a cliff nearly 200 feet above the blue waters of the Aegean, this imposing marble temple was constructed in the 5<sup>th</sup> century BC and dedicated to the God of the Sea. With historical insights from your guide, intertwined with some of the many legends about the Temple of Poseidon, your exploration is enhanced by spectacular views of the sea. Before returning to Athens, sit down to a freshly prepared seafood lunch at one of our favorite tavernas in the Sounion area. *This tour lasts approximately 6 to 7 hours. Roundtrip chauffeured transportation from Athens, lunch and entry fees are included.*
