Enhance Your Stay in Naples with Additional Privately Guided Sightseeing

Art, Architecture + Trains - Private Walking Tour: The "Art Stations" of the Naples Metro system are the culmination of a civic effort to bring contemporary artwork into an urban context. Descend beneath the city streets with your personal guide to learn about the architectural and artistic marvels created by designers and architects from around the world. Among the crown jewels is the Toledo Metro station, designed by Spanish architect Oscar Tousquets Blanca and recognized by LEAF (Leading European Architects Forum) as the Public Building of the Year in 2013. *This 3-hour tour begins outside the main entrance of the National Archaeological Museum. It is offered daily. Some blackout dates may apply.*

Private Half-Day Tour to Pompeii: Enjoy the short drive to Pompeii, a once thriving port and sophisticated city of ancient Rome. In the year 79 AD, a cataclysmic eruption buried Pompeii and thousands of its inhabitants under 13 to 20 feet of volcanic ash. Today, the vast archaeological site is recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. With insight and information from your personal guide, it's remarkably preserved villas, frescoes, baths and other public buildings offer an almost you-are-there look into the life and culture of ancient Rome. *This 3-hour tour includes roundtrip chauffeured transportation from Naples and your entrance fee to Pompeii. It is offered daily. Some blackout dates may apply.*

Private Full-Day Tour to Pompeii & Herculaneum: Lovers of archaeology will not want to miss this chance to visit both of these historic sites. After your privately guided tour through the ruins of Pompeii, you'll continue to Herculaneum, a once-wealthy resort town that lay closer to the Bay of Naples than Pompeii. Due to its location west of Mt. Vesuvius, ancient Herculaneum escaped the initial column of volcanic ash, gas and pumice that rained down upon Pompeii to the southeast. Although it was ultimately buried by subsequent pyroclastic flows, the destruction in Herculaneum was less. The result is a remarkable collection of well-preserved buildings, many with their second levels still intact. The frescoes and mosaics here in Herculaneum also retain a surprising degree of their original color and vibrancy. *This 7-hour tour includes roundtrip chauffeured transportation from Naples and all entrance fees. It is offered daily except Wednesday. Some blackout dates may apply.*

Private Full-Day Tour to Pompeii & Mt. Vesuvius: Enjoy the short drive to Pompeii where you'll meet your personal guide for a fascinating tour of this once thriving and sophisticated city of ancient Rome. Destroyed 2,000 years ago by the cataclysmic eruption of Mt. Vesuvius, this vast archaeological site is recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. With fascinating insight and information from your personal guide, Pompeii's remarkably preserved villas, frescoes, baths and other public buildings offer a captivating look into daily life in ancient Roman times. Before returning to Naples, you'll drive up the slopes of Mt. Vesuvius to get a closer look at the source of Pompeii's destruction. From the parking area, a maintained trail ascends from 3,280 feet to 4,000 feet. Just 200 feet from the summit of Mt. Vesuvius, you'll have breathtaking views over the region – an area that the ancient Romans called "Campania Felix" in recognition of its beauty. *This 7-hour tour includes roundtrip chauffeured transportation from Naples and all entrance fees. It is offered daily. Some blackout dates may apply.*

Private Full-Day Excursion to Ischia: Situated at the northern entrance to the Bay of Naples, surrounded by the azure waters of the Tyrrhenian Sea, Ischia is hailed as one of the region's most picturesque islands. Accompanied by your own personal guide, this full-day excursion will reveal the island's natural beauty and the vibrant spirit of its inhabitants. You'll spend time at a local vineyard, sit down to a delightful lunch, and have time to visit Aragonese Castle; set on a rocky islet, this medieval landmark traces its history to an even earlier ancient fortress that was built by Hiero I of Syracuse in the 5th century BC. *This full day excursion includes roundtrip chauffeured transfers to/from the pier in Naples, jetfoil transportation to Ischia, and our privately guided services including winery visit, lunch, and entrance fee to Aragonese Castle. It is offered daily. Some blackout dates may apply.*
